On Friday morning, January 19, 2024, at the Global Methodist Church Conference the laity met with Michelle Tepperer of Alpha. Alpha is an anointed worldwide evangelism/discipleship ministry developed to create a safe space for conversations about faith. Currently 127 denominations are using Alpha.

From Alpha's web page (alphausa.org):

"In a world of isolation, anonymity, and keyboardwarriors, Alpha offers content and guidance for churches, ministries, and individuals to create a space for honest and open conversations about life's biggest questions. Everyone is welcome and no questions are off limits.

Creating these spaces for honest, open, and judgment-free conversations for anyone to explore the Christian faith is so important to us that we give all of the digital assets to run Alpha away for free. How can we do this? We have hundreds of donors committed to the important mission."

The Alpha program is about Jesus and offering "front porch" hospitality. <u>Inviting</u> people to our "front porch" (a dedicated space); having <u>Interactive Sessions</u> – food, talk, discussion; and, for the Host and Helpers - learning to <u>Listen</u> – as Jesus listened.

<u>Prayer</u> – for someone who has never experienced the love of Jesus, prayer can change everything.

<u>Evangelism</u> – spreading the Christian gospel.

<u>Discipleship</u> – spend dedicated time with, pray for, build a friendship with and intentionally teach how to grow in faith – winning others to Christ and getting them involved in the process of winning others to Christ.

<u>Belonging</u>. Not <u>Just Welcoming</u> - As we invite people and grow our hospitality, people should feel they are not only <u>welcome</u>, but that they <u>belong</u>.

Michelle told us that the program is designed to fail unless God shows up.


