CATHOLICISM KEY INSIGHTS

Catholics make up the largest group of Christians in the world- over one billion. In the United States, Protestants outnumber Catholics 2 to 1.

Catholic priests are prohibited from marriage. There are records of 6 Popes who were married...including Peter (the first Pope). There is no record of Popes (Catholic) marrying after they have been installed. -Mark 1:29-31, 1 Corinthians 7:7

Scripture and Tradition

In addition to the Bible, Catholic doctrine is based on the teachings of the church and the decisions of councils and bishops summarized in the "Roman Catholic Catechism."

Celebrate 7 Sacraments

A Christian rite (as baptism or the Eucharist) that is believed to have been ordained by Christ and that is held to be a means of divine grace or to be a sign or symbol of a spiritual reality. (Baptism, communion, confirmation, confession, marriage, sacred orders, last rites or anointing the sick.)

Faith Responders:
The Disaster Response Partner of the
Global Methodist Church

Hurricane Beryl struck the Texas coast on July 8th as a Category 1 storm, causing a storm surge of 3-4 feet. The hurricane landed just north of Corpus Christi, taking Houston by surprise and leaving over 2 million residents without power in the city and surrounding areas. As the hurricane season has begun, please keep those affected by this early season storm in your thoughts and prayers. We are currently assessing the needs and preparing to help.

Last week, Faith Responders was in Ruidoso, New Mexico, where wildfires and flooding left 1009 people homeless and another 600 dealing with significant damage to their homes. The wildfires burned over 10,000 acres, making the area susceptible to flash flooding. The community has come together to support those in temporary shelters and aid in their recovery. Faith Responders spent four days with Community Methodist Church to plan and set up their response for the community.

Additionally, Faith Responders continues to support the long-term recovery efforts in Taylor County and the initial recovery efforts of those affected by the Tallahassee tornadoes.
