

# Christianity's Family Tree Orthodoxy (Mystery, Liturgy, and Tradition)

The first followers of Christ, the first Christians, were Jews that called themselves, "Followers of the Way." 1/3 of all Jews recognized Jesus as the Messiah, The Truth, and the Way.

In 325 (Nicene Council) the church sought to define itself and stand as its own entity. Despite the coming together of solidarity with the Nicene Creed, there were difference between the Eastern and Western Christians. These differences were more cultural, philosophical, and political than theological.

### The West (Catholic Church) Rome: Leader = Pope

Christians in the west spoke Latin and the services were in Latin. They viewed the gospel in concrete terms. They had an emphasis on sin and justice within their theology.

# The East (Orthodox Church) *Constantinople: Leader* = *Patriarchs*

Christians in the east spoke Greek and the services were in Greek. They made a greater allowance for mystery, for experiencing God. They had an emphasis on salvation rooted in our experience of death and resurrection.

## THE SCHISM...THE BREAK

The *FILIOQUE* (Fil'i'o'que) Clause In **AD 589**, a church council in Toledo, Spain, modified the Nicene Creed so that the Holy Spirit is said to proceed from the Father *and the Son*.

## The Council of Lyons (1274)

The filioque clause became part of the Nicene Creed in the Roman Catholic Church. The Eastern church was not invited.

## ORTHODOXY DOCTRINE

#### The Human Condition, Salvation, and Sanctification

- Death is passed down to generations, not Original Sin
- Salvation is through Jesus Christ
- Sanctification is through participation of worship, the Divine Liturgy, prayer, and pursuit of the seven mysteries of the sacraments.

Scripture and Tradition

They reject the concept of "sola scriptura". They have a collection of writings (much like our commentaries) that have stories of martyrs, letters, sermons, etc.

### Reality

The Orthodox Church reminds us (our jobs, our schooling, our relationships) are not the real world. The real world is Heaven, God's eternal kingdom: And real life is found in participating in that divine kingdom now, here on earth.

• Thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in Heaven.

### Surrounded by a Great Cloud of Witnesses

*Veneration*: respect or awe inspired by the dignity, wisdom, dedication, or talent of a person.

"We do not worship those who are pictured on the icons. We venerate them and we look to them-specifically, the saints of the church-as good examples to follow."

While on this earth, you will never be closer to a loved one that has passed on than when you are in worship. The great cloud of witnesses is before God right now. Therefore, in worship you and your loved ones are worshiping side by side facing our great and glorious Lord.
