A Brief History of Martin Luther

Martin Luther- (1483-1546), German reformer

Luther was haunted by insecurity about his salvation (he describes these insecurities in striking tones and calls them Anfectungen or Afflictions.) A monastery was the perfect place to find assurance. However, the assurance that he longed for still eluded him in the monastery. It is through his search for Christ that Luther came to the cornerstone of the Protestant reformation. Humankind is justified and made right with God not by our works, but by God's work in Jesus Christ.

A Church in Need of Reform

Selling of Indulgences- Indulgence was a permission to sin and yet be free from its consequences. Like all great evils, it came in gradually.

Doctrine of Purgatory- The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* defines purgatory as a "purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven," which is experienced by those "who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified". Revelations 21:27

Intercession and power of the Priest- The priest was to stand between humanity and God and act as an intermediary. Exodus 20:18-21

Infallibility of the Pope- Vatican II. Luke 10:16, Matt. 18:18 Lutheran Beliefs and Practices

The Priesthood of All Believers- "He was really talking about the vocation to which each and every Christian is called. It means that everyone who follows Jesus is called to use the gifts that God has given in our life's ministry in the world. To be a Christian, one does not need to live in a monastery or be ordained to serve as a pastor or bishop." -Bishop Gerald Mansholt - Exodus 19:5-6

Sola Scriptura- "scripture alone"- The Bible and the Bible alone was to be the primary authority in defining the faith and practice of Christians, not the bishops, popes, or councils.

Justification by Faith, Not Works- In the midst's of his struggles, Luther came to the insight that he could not earn salvation or God's grace through works. Salvation and grace are experienced through God's gift of Jesus Christ. "Faith is God's work in us, that changes us and gives new birth from God." – Martin Luther -John 1:13

Faith Responders: The Disaster Response Partner of the **Global Methodist Church** Hurricane Beryl struck the Texas coast
