

THE HISTORY OF PRESBYTERIANISM

Their Name-

Presbyterians draw their name from the way they organized, adapting the Greek New Testament word "elder" ...presbuteros...Presbyterians are those whose church organization does not include bishops, but rather includes elders who lead each local congregation.

Founder-

John Calvin, born in 1509, was 8 years old when Luther posted his ninety-five theses. Calvin studied law in Paris (Luther did too) and in his early 20's had a conversion experience. Following this conversion, Calvin became an avid Protestant seeking to reform the church. Not just the Catholic church...but also the Lutherans.

Calvin and his followers respected Luther and his challenge of the Catholic faith...However, they felt that Luther did not go far enough in his protest and instituted changes from the Catholic church.

TULIP- 5 point Calvinism

T- Total Depravity- We are so lost and broken by original sin that we cannot even turn toward God.

U- Unconditional Election- (predestination) God has chosen some to be saved...consequently...he has chosen some to be damned. You do not choose God...God Chooses you.

L- Limited Atonement- Christ death bought salvation not for all, but only for the elect. Christ only died for the ones that God chooses.

I- Irresistible Grace- If you are among the chosen or elect of God, you cannot refuse God's salvation. You have no free will.

P- Perseverance- (once saved always saved) The elect cannot lose their salvation.


