

Christianity's Family Tree: Baptist: Baptism, Conversion, and Scripture

Puritan Theory Separatist Theory- (*This is the more popular theory and presents most facts*) *In* the 1600's, there were many who were dissatisfied with the middle path of the Church of England. They sought to purge the church of its Catholic or "high church" elements; to restore it to what they believed was the Apostolic Church and New Testament character; and to purify the church and its members, challenging them to lead a holy life.

John Smyth was the first Baptist pastor on record according to the Puritan Separatist Theory. He established his church in 1609, and on the first Sunday he "rebaptized" all the adults who had been baptized as infants.

How many Baptist sub-denominations are there? Today...51 million Baptist "worldwide" 33 million live in the United States.

FOUR CORE BELIEFS OR EMPHASES OF BAPTISTS:

The inspiration, infallibility, and preservation of Scripture: There can be some disagreement from how the Baptist and other Protestant denominations interpret "inspired" by God. Many Baptists follow a "verbal, plenary inspiration." This means God took over the writer and penned all the words within the Holy Scriptures. 2 Tm 3:16-17

The inerrancy of scripture: Is the view that when all the facts become known, they will demonstrate that the Bible *in its original autographs* and correctly interpreted is entirely true and never false in all it affirms, whether that relates to doctrines or ethics or to the social, physical, or life sciences."

Salvation by grace through faith alone: Insight that one could not earn salvation or God's grace through works. Salvation and grace are experienced through God's gift of Jesus Christ. Rm 3:21-24

The importance of one's personal relationship with God: Jesus' practice both corporate worship and personal worship.
