Pentecostalism: The Power of The Spirit

The Birth of the Pentecostal Church

Church history shares that the Pentecostal church was born out of a holiness movement at Bethel Bible College in Topeka, Kansas. Professor Charles Fox Parham (who had a Methodist background...at one time he was a supply pastor for the Methodist Episcopal North church) was teaching at Bethel Bible College in Topeka, Kansas. His class was studying the Book of Acts, and he began to wonder if the works of the Holy Spirit recorded there could still happen in the church.

Several years later, Parham hooked up with a man named William J. Seymour and they were preaching at a revival in an old abandoned Methodist Church in Los Angeles. The Holy Spirit showed up there with the same power that it showed up at the ACTS church. This would later be called the Azuza Street revival...and for some, this would be considered the birthplace of the Pentecostal church.

THE FOUR MAJOR EMPHASES OF PENTECOSTALISM

The Baptism or infilling of the Holy Spirit (second baptism)

Pentecostals believe that after the Spirit comes upon us when we commit our lives to Christ, there is a subsequent experience (second work of grace) at which time the Holy Spirit completely immerses believers, filling them with power.

Having a personal relationship with Jesus Christ

Pentecostals place a strong emphasis on the emotional dimensions of one's relationship with Jesus Christ. This is reflected in much of their music. Songs are meant to describe various aspects of a personal relationship and lean away from corporate worship.

The second coming of Jesus Christ

According to Pentecostal biblical interpretation of Joel 2...**God's Spirit will be poured out in the last days**. The fact that the church has "rediscovered" these gifts

that were present in the Apostolic church...this is a sign that the end is near.

Modern-day miracles and healing

Jesus himself promised we would see miracles happen. (Mark 16:17; Luke 21:11, 25) The Book of James (5:14) assures us that if any are sick...we are to call for the elders of the church to anoint that person and pray. There is a greater sense of expectation within Pentecostal churches that God is in the "miracleworking business.
