Christianity's Family Tree Methodism: The Extreme Center

John Wesley (June 17, 1703 - March 2, 1791) In his early years, Wesley's faith could be categorized as intellectual. His faith was very cerebral...much like the Presbyterian movement. However, he always had a deep yearning to experience a faith that was not luke-warm. One of his fears was to be a Nominal Christian.

Charles Wesley (*December 18, 1707 -* March 29, 1788)

He was not a writer of music. He was said to have averaged 10 poetic lines a day for 50 years. He wrote 8,989 hymns. He composed some of the most memorable and lasting hymns of the church. As one historian put it, "The early Methodists were taught and led as much through [Charles's] hymns as through sermons and [John] Wesley's pamphlets."

Beliefs and Practices of Methodism

Ecumenical- Methodist were ecumenical and willing to work with and learn from Christians of other denominations.

Passion and Experience- Methodist valued passion and experience. Wesley embraced experience as a means of knowing God. Our Pentecostal connection.

Free Will- Although Wesley was ecumenical...there was theology that he would stand against. Wesley vigorously argued against "predestination". Romans 10:12

GRACE (God's Redemption At Christ's Expense)

Prevenient Grace- The grace that goes before... preparing the way.

Justification- The moment that all your sins are forgiving and set right before God. The work of Christ on the cross takes effect and you have admitted that you are a sinner in need of forgiveness...12 step program.

Sanctification- (holiness)- As Methodist, we recognize that it is only by God's Grace that we have life and salvation. At the same time, Methodist believe that we are saved from sin in order to do good works. Sanctification or holiness means to have one's heart so transformed by the power of the Holy Spirit that one manifests perfect love for God and neighbor.
