Jesus Wants to Share Your Burden

Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me; for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light. — Matthew 11:28-30 (RSV)

I don't know the specific burdens you are carrying today. I don't know what has been weighing on your heart, keeping you up at night, or filling your mind with worry. But I do know this: You don't have to carry it alone.

Jesus, in His infinite love and grace, invites us to come to Him. He knows our struggles, our fears, and our weariness. When life feels overwhelming, when the weight of our responsibilities presses down on us, He gently calls us to lay it all at His feet.

For a long time, I didn't quite understand what Jesus meant when He said, "Take my yoke upon you." At first, it seemed like He was asking me to carry even more—but I came to realize that a yoke is not a burden; it is a gift.



A yoke is a wooden frame that connects two oxen together, allowing them to share the load. Instead of one struggling alone, they work in unity, making the work lighter. This is what Jesus offers us. He is not giving us more to bear—He is offering to bear our burdens with us.

When you take His yoke upon you, you are no longer walking through your troubles alone. You are moving forward with Christ, step by step, at His pace. He sets the direction. He carries the weight. And He gives you peace along the way.

Jesus calls us to come, learn, and take. Come to Him, just as you are, weary and burdened. Learn from Him—His gentleness, His patience, His way of handling the storms of life. And take on His yoke, trusting that He will walk beside you, lighten your load, and bring you the rest your soul has been longing for.

If you are struggling today, I encourage you to accept Jesus' invitation. Don't try to carry the weight alone. Let Him shoulder it with you. Let Him guide you. Let Him give you peace.

You are deeply loved, and you are not alone.

Easter Sunrise Service


