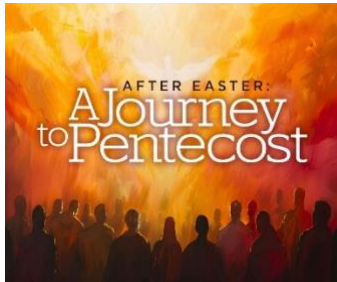

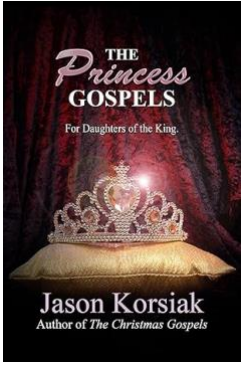
Mission and Outreach Coming Up
