
Joy That Endures

"But let all who take refuge in you be glad; let them ever sing for joy. Spread your protection over them, that those who love your name may rejoice in you."

— Psalm 5:11

Christmas is one of the most joyful times of the year — and rightfully so. We celebrate the birth of Jesus, our Savior, the One who came into the world to rescue us from sin and bring us new life. The lights, music, and gatherings all point to something deeper: a joy that is rooted not in our present circumstances, but in God's eternal promise.



But let's be honest — joy isn't always easy to feel. For some, this season brings grief, stress, or reminders of what's been lost. Even in everyday life, joy can feel far off when the car breaks down, when finances are tight, or when life simply wears us down. I understand this deeply — as someone who tends to see the glass half empty (and probably full of backwash), the idea of joy has not come naturally to me.

Yet Scripture doesn't speak of joy as a fleeting emotion. It speaks of a joy that remains — a joy that comes from knowing who we are and whose we are. Jesus Himself said in John 16:20-22 that we would face sorrow, but that our grief would turn into joy. He compared it to a mother giving birth: the pain is real, but it gives way to overwhelming joy when the child arrives. In the same way, we walk through trials knowing that joy is coming — and that no one can take it from us.

A wise pastor once told me, "Being joyful doesn't mean pretending to be happy all the time." That truth has stuck with me. We don't have to smile through suffering or minimize pain. But we can hold onto a deeper truth: that we've been rescued. That our sins are forgiven. That God is with us, even when life is hard.

This Christmas (in July), I encourage you to reflect on the source of our joy. Not on how things are going, but on the One who came to be with us — Immanuel. Because of Jesus, our joy doesn't depend on how we feel today or what tomorrow brings. It springs from the salvation that was born into a manger — and now lives in our hearts.


Whatever your situation this season, may you remember that joy. May it be your strength, your song, and your anchor — not just at Christmas, but always.

July Special Mission and Outreach




For the month of July, we will have a special sermon series called: "Christmas in July". With this sermon series we, members of our congregation, will have the opportunity to participate in a global mission called:
