

Sitting in God's Waiting Room

There's a gap between when God makes a promise and when we see it fulfilled. That space is what I call "the



waiting place." Abraham waited 25 years for a son. Joseph waited 13 years for his dream to come true. David waited 15 years to become king. Even Jesus said He was coming back "soon," and we're still waiting.

Waiting is hard — not because we doubt the promise, but because we don't know how long it will take. That's where faith is tested. So how do we wait well?

1. The Waiting Place Is Where the Battle Is Fought

It's easy to pray. The hard part is holding onto faith when nothing seems to be changing. This is where hope and fear wrestle. Keep fighting to believe — because breakthrough only comes *after* the waiting.

2. Waiting Is Active, Not Passive

Biblical waiting means *expecting* and *preparing*. It's applying for the job, getting the loan pre-approved, or starting the ministry — even before results show. Jesus said, "*Keep on asking, keep on seeking, keep on knocking*" (Matthew 7:7). Waiting is not sitting still — it's moving in faith.

3. God Cannot Lie

When doubts creep in, remember this truth: "It is impossible for God to lie" (Hebrews 6:18). If He promised it, He will do it. The enemy wants you to question God's Word, just like in the Garden of Eden. Resist the lie. Trust the truth.

4. God's Promises Anchor You

"This hope is a strong and trustworthy anchor for our souls" (Hebrews 6:19). Storms may come, but when you're anchored in God's promises, you won't drift. Find a promise, cling to it, and let it hold you steady while you wait.

5. The Promise Leads to His Presence

The waiting place is meant to draw you closer to God. His presence is where fear fades and hope is restored. When you spend time with Him, your burdens get lighter, and your soul gets stronger. You don't just wait for God — you wait with God.


Pastor Visit

What is Back to Church Sunday? Date: September 21, 2025

National Back to Church Sunday started in 2009 with a simple but bold idea: What if churches made a special effort to invite people back to church on one Sunday of the year? This day was set aside for churches to rally together after summer break, welcome their communities through their doors, and remind people that hope is found in Jesus and in the Church community.

According to experts, 82% of people say they'd attend church if a friend simply invited them, but only 2% of churchgoers ever do. Back to Church Sunday aims to close that gap. Each year, those churches who participate often see a 25–27% increase in attendance on that Sunday alone!
