## The Church: A Family, a Fellowship, and the Body of Jesus Christ

Can you define what a Christian is without mentioning the church? If you can, then your definition likely doesn't line up with the Bible.

Think of it this way: An orphan doesn't adopt parents—parents adopt the orphan. And once that child is adopted, everything changes. He takes the family name. He eats at the family table. He becomes a brother or sister to the other children. He is not alone anymore.



In Christ, we have been adopted into God's family (Eph. 1:5). Our name is no longer our own; it is "Christian." We belong to the household of God, with brothers and sisters in the faith. The Bible does not picture us as spiritual loners—it pictures us as family, fellowship, body, bride, people, temple. Always together.

That means to call yourself a Christian while refusing to

belong to a church is a contradiction. It would be like a finger declaring independence from the hand, or an eye saying it doesn't need the body (1 Cor. 12:21). Such an idea makes no sense in Scripture.

### The Local Church Is Not Optional

Yes, there is the universal church—every believer across time and place. But the New Testament overwhelmingly points us to local churches, real gatherings of real people, meeting in real places. Paul wrote letters not to "all believers everywhere" but to the "church in Corinth" and the "churches in Galatia."

Why? Because faith in Christ is always meant to take flesh in fellowship with others. To join Christ is to join His people. To belong to Him is to belong to them.

The writer of Hebrews gives us a sober warning: "Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching" (Heb. 10:25). To neglect the gathering is not a small matter. It's a sign of spiritual danger, of drifting, of hardening hearts.

### The Church Is Where Faith Becomes Visible

Memorizing Bible verses, praying before meals, and listening to Christian music are good. But the true test of the Spirit's work in us is this: Do we forgive? Do we bear with one another? Do we love when it would be easier to walk away?

That can only happen in the mess and beauty of church life. Alone, you cannot practice patience, kindness, forgiveness, or sacrifice. These graces only appear when we live side by side with other believers—sinners like us—who give us plenty of opportunities to display Christ's love.

#### A Call to Action

Friend, don't fool yourself with vague talk of "believing in God" while living apart from His people. The Bible does not know a Christian who refuses the church. Except for rare circumstances, a true believer plants their life in a local fellowship, worships with them, serves with them, suffers with them, rejoices with them.

This is not about checking a Sunday box. This is about living out who you really are in Christ.

Together, we display the gospel. Together, we show the world that Jesus reconciles sinners—not just to God but also to one another. Together, we shine brighter than we ever could apart.

So do not neglect the church. Do not drift away. Commit yourself. Be present. Take your place at the table. Your family is waiting for you.

### **WIH WILL GRAHAM**




Leading up to the **Good News Tour** this fall, the Billy Graham Ministry will be providing practical training that will equip Christians to live out their faith and share it with others.
