

Labor Day: A Religious Inspiration

For many, Labor Day is seen only as a national holiday marking the end of summer. But its roots remind us of a deeper truth: our labor is not just about earning a wage—it is an expression of God's calling in our lives.

When America shifted from farms to factories during the Industrial Revolution, workers were pushed to exhaustion: twelve-hour days, seven days a week, even for children. Out of this hardship came the cry for justice, echoing the words of Scripture: "The laborer deserves his wages" (Luke 10:7). Labor unions, advocacy, and voices like Dorothy Day's reminded the nation that every worker bears the image of God and deserves dignity, rest, and fair treatment.



In 1894, Labor Day was established as a way to honor American workers. But as Christians, we can see beyond the holiday itself. Labor is sacred because it reflects the God who worked to create the world and then rested on the seventh day. Colossians 3:23 calls us: "Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters." Our work—whether in factories, offices, schools, homes, or fields—is a form of worship when done with integrity, service, and love.

So as we celebrate Labor Day, let us give thanks not only for fairer working conditions but also for the gift of work itself. May we see our daily labor as part of our discipleship and offer it as worship to the One who labors in love for us all.


NO KID SLEEPS ON THE FLOOR IN OUR TOWN!

National Back to Church Sunday started in 2009 with a simple but bold idea: What if churches made a special effort to invite people back to church on one Sunday of the year? This day was set aside for churches to rally together after summer break, welcome their communities through their doors, and remind people that hope is found in Jesus and in the Church community.

According to experts, 82% of people say they'd attend church if a friend simply invited them, but only 2% of churchgoers ever do. Back to Church Sunday aims to close that gap. Each year, those churches who participate often see a 25–27% increase in attendance on that Sunday alone!

Because of Back to church Sunday...our monthly potluck at the church will be moved from September 7th to September 21st.




