Show Your Joy to the World

"But I have trusted in Your mercy; My heart shall rejoice in Your salvation. I will sing to the Lord, Because He has dealt bountifully with me." Psalm 13:5-6

As Christmas approaches, I want to speak to you not just as your pastor, but as someone who cares deeply about your heart and your experience this season. I know how easy it is for December to fill up with stress, busyness, and even comparison. Maybe you're feeling overwhelmed by all there is to do, or maybe you're wishing things could be different in your home or your heart. If that's you, please know—you're not alone.

But here's my loving challenge to you, and to myself: What if, this year, we chose something different? What if, instead of letting panic, frustration, regret, or envy take over, we asked God to fill us with joy—real, deep, lasting joy? Not the kind that depends on perfect plans or perfect decorations, but the kind that comes from knowing we are loved, saved, and held by God.

The psalmist says, "But I have trusted in Your mercy; My heart shall rejoice in Your salvation. I will sing to the Lord, because He has dealt bountifully with me." This is the joy I want for you. It's a joy that celebrates the miracle of Jesus coming into our world, a joy that lifts us up even when life feels heavy. It's a joy that can change not just how we feel, but how we treat each other—making us kinder, more patient, and more grateful.

So, my challenge is this: Let's chase after that joy together. Let's pause, even for a moment, to thank God for the gift of Jesus. Let's let that gratitude overflow into our words and actions, so that everyone around us can see the real reason we celebrate. You don't need a spotless house or a homemade fruitcake to show joy to the world—just a heart open to God's love.

May you feel the warmth of Christ's love in your heart and home this season. And may your joy be so real that it shines out to everyone you meet.


So, dress up in your warm clothes and plan on spreading some Christmas cheer to the Chaires community. To ensure that we have enough space on the trailer.

How to Participate

Baking and Packaging: Anyone interested in contributing baked treats is encouraged to bring their goodies to the church on **December 24th at 3:00 p.m.** At this time, the baked goods will be packaged and prepared for delivery.

Early Delivery Option: Volunteers who plan to both bake and deliver may take their packages with them on December 24th, allowing them to make deliveries at their convenience on December 25th, without needing to return to the church on Christmas Day.

Delivery Only Option: Those who wish to help deliver but are unable to bake can meet at the church on **December 25th at 10:00 a.m.** Together, the group will divide the baked goods and set out to distribute them to area first responders.

This project is a wonderful opportunity to give back and make a difference for those who serve our community, especially during the holiday season.
