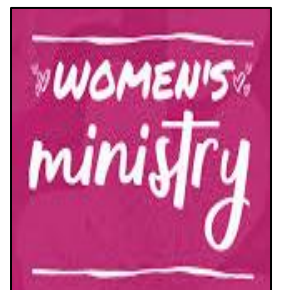
Women's Ministry

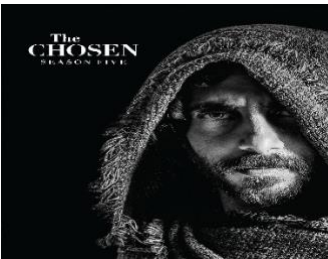
