Being Renewed in Christ

Dear Church Family,

As we step into a new season together, I am reminded of the encouragement found in 1 John 2:5-6. John writes that those who keep God's commands are truly living in Him and that we should walk as Jesus walked. This is a beautiful call for us to be renewed in Christ, allowing His life to shape our choices and our community.

Renewal in Christ begins with a heart that honors God's Word. When we take His commands seriously, we open ourselves to His transforming work. It means we turn away from sin with honest repentance (*Matthew 4:17*). It means we serve one another, just as Christ served us (*Philippians 2*). Renewal leads us to seek reconciliation with each other when relationships are strained (*Matthew 5:23-25*). It encourages us to keep our promises, reflecting integrity in all we say (*Matthew 5:37*). And it calls us to lift each other up in prayer, remembering that God's house is to be a house of prayer for all people (*Matthew 21:13*).

A key part of this renewal, as 1 John 1:7 reminds us, is walking in the light as Christ is in the light, which brings us into true fellowship with one another and allows the blood of Jesus to cleanse us from all sin.

When we honor God's word and strive to live as He commands, we are not only transformed individually, but our community is strengthened in unity and love. Renewal in Christ means choosing the light—choosing honesty, forgiveness, and love—so that we may experience deeper fellowship and ongoing cleansing through Christ.

Practical ways to walk in the light each day include:

- Spend time in Scripture and prayer daily, allowing God's truth to guide your thoughts and actions.
- Practice honesty and transparency in your words and relationships, being willing to admit faults and seek forgiveness when needed.
- Forgive those who have wronged you, letting go of bitterness and opening your heart to reconciliation.
- Serve others in practical ways, offering encouragement, help, or a listening ear to those in need.
- Choose integrity in all you do, making decisions that reflect Christ's character even when no one is watching.
- Stay connected to fellow believers, joining in fellowship, worship, and mutual support that helps you grow in faith.

As we put these practices into action, we step more fully into the light of Christ, allowing His love to renew us and unite our church family in grace.


